**Eligibility Criteria**

For the

**New Jersey American Legion Leadership College**

**All Legionaries** in good standing with an active American Legion Post in the Department of New Jersey are eligible to attend all courses offered by the college. These being...

Basic

Advanced

(Basic is required before attending Advanced, also completion of National Online training is recommended)

Post Service Officer

Membership

Post Management

Chaplain

Legionnaires may also attend the two SAL courses but must complete SAL Basic before attending SAL Advanced.

All Student candidates must complete the application for the desired course, this must be submitted to the Department with the Signature of the Commander who is sponsoring the application. A sponsoring Command may be a Post, the County or the Department. Appropriate payment must accompany the application. Checks and money orders are accepted, no cash will be accepted (It is recommended that the Applicant's Post/County pay the enrolment fee) The application must be received at the Department headquarters prior to the Registration cutoff date listed on the application.

SAL Members in good standing with an active Squadron in the Detachment of New Jersey are eligible to attend the SAL College courses. The Basic course must be completed prior to attending the Advanced. Once an SAL Member has completed the SAL College courses they are eligible to participate in the American Legion Courses, with the exception of the Post Management course (SAL Members can not sign or be named to certain committees of an American Legion Post, only American Legion Members can have legal obligations)
